EMERGENCY MEDICINE RESIDENCY
POLICY ON MOONLIGHTING**

The residency program is aware of the desire of residents to moonlight. However, in order to obtain and retain the privilege of moonlighting, the following rules must be upheld:

1. Residents are not allowed to begin moonlighting until they have received permission from the Program Director, and this will not occur until the resident has completed their EM2 year. Exception: residents who are board certified/eligible in another specialty may request permission from the Program Director to moonlight in their prior specialty during their EM2 year.
2. Only residents who are in good standing with the residency are eligible to moonlight. Residents who are on probation or remediation are not permitted to moonlight.
3. Residents must keep an accurate “Moonlighting Verification Form” on file with the Residency Coordinator at all times.
4. Moonlighting may not interfere with any residency-related activities (conference attendance, shifts, residency retreats, electives, presentations, jeopardy, etc.).
5. The total hours spent moonlighting cannot be more than 24 hours per month.
6. Moonlighting counts towards the ACGME duty hour limits and may not result in any duty hours violations. Moonlighting hours must be logged on Verinform as part of required duty hours monitoring
7. A resident may not work more than five shifts, including moonlighting or required residency duties, in a seven-day period.
8. A resident may not schedule a moonlighting shift when they are on Jeopardy.
9. The residency strongly encourages residents to moonlight in a setting with adequate specialty backup and malpractice coverage.

If moonlighting results in a duty hours violation or in any way interferes with residency activities or resident performance permission to moonlight will be rescinded and the resident will be required to cease moonlighting at once.

MOONLIGHTING ACTIVITY VERIFICATION FORM
